Glossary:

Meadows: land that is covered with grass.



Stooping: bending your body forward and downward.



Underneath: under or below something else, especially when it is hidden or covered by the thing or top.

Drooping: bending, hanging or moving downwards especially because of being weak or tired.

Merely: only.

Pale: having skin that is almost white, having skin that is whiter than usual because of illness.

Burden: a duty, responsibility, etc. that causes worry, difficulty or hard work.
