- 1. Who rescued the two children?
Where did they take them to?**

Answer: “The Childline” and “Child Labour” Enforcement Team” rescued the two children.

“The Childline” took Romesh to Andhra Pradesh and he is now one of the beneficiaries of Andhra Pradesh state based project for the elimination of child labour. The “Child Labour Enforcement Team” rescued Shanti and kept her in a girl’s transit home.

- 2. What is the role of CRY?**

Answer: The role of CRY is to partner some basic level organisation working for children, their parents and communities. They do not believe in charity nor do they run schools or orphanages. They acts as a bridge between the development of a child and people working for the marginalised children.

- 3. To whom can a child report about abuse?**

Answers: A child can report abuse to The Childline, call 1098, Child Labour

Enforcement Team Child Rights and You(CRY).
