Glossary (Learn words from the lesson) PART 1

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pavilion: building that is built as a shelter	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Thatched roof: roof made with dried straw	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tree stumps: after a tree is cut or fell, the stump is usually a small remaining portion of the trunk with the roots still in the ground.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Twigs: a small very thin branch that grows out of a larger branch.	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sand bank: a deposit of sand forming a shallow area in the sea or river. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ebony: the hard black wood of various tropical trees. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hatchet: a tool with a heavy blade for chopping things with a short handle ; small axe 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Saplings: a young tree

- **Pounds:** a unit of measuring weight
