LINEAR EQUATIONS IN ONE VARIABLE

EXPRESSION:

A combination of constants and variables by the four basic mathematical operations (+, -, \times , \div) is called an “**Expression**”.

Examples:

1) $3x^2 + 3x - 4$

2) $4x^{1/3} + 5x + 2\sqrt{x}$

3) $4x^{-2} + 5x + 3$
