

HUMAN REPRODUCTION

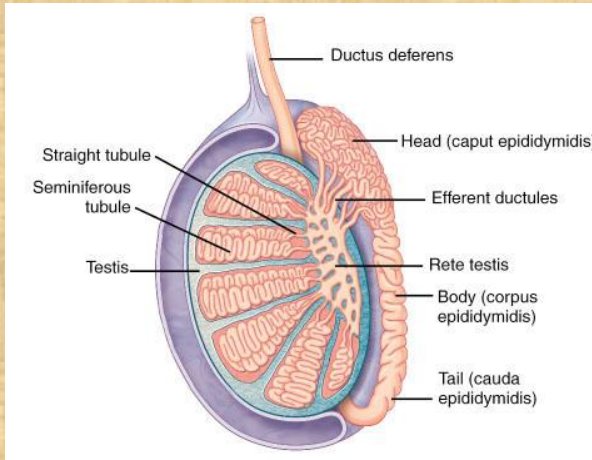


Figure: Testis

Adults - Oval shape

Length - 4 to 5 cm

Width - 2 to 3 cm

Testis covered by a dense covering.

Tunica vaginalis:

It is a flat sac, filled coelomic fluid, which helps the testis in Friction less sliding.

Tunica albuginea:

Fibrous or collangenous connective tissue.

Tunica vasculosa:

Delicate, loose, lines testicular lobules has rich supply of blood capillaries.

Tunica albuginea (undergoes):

Divides the major part of the testis in to about 250 testicular lobules by forming ventricular partitions, in which sperms are produced.
